PROCEDURE OF ADOPTION OF AN ORDINANCE

1. Move that the Council take up an Ordinance.
2. Move that the Ordinance be read the first time for information.
3. Move (that the rules be suspended and) that the Ordinance under consideration be read for the second time by its title only.
4. Move (that the rules be suspended and) that the Ordinance under consideration be read for the third time by its title only.
5. Move (that the rules be suspended and) that the Ordinance under consideration be placed on its final passage and adopted as read.

MEETINGS

The City Council shall hold its regular meetings at the Council Hall on the second Monday in each month, at 7:30 o'clock, P.M. Adjourned meetings are customarily held at 7:30 P.M. on the 1st and 4th Monday of each month. Special meetings shall be held at the same place, and at the same time in the day.

SPECIAL MEETINGS

The Mayor, or a majority of the members of the City Council, may call a Special Meeting of the Council by notice in writing, signed by him or them, to each member thereof, personally served, or left at his residence, and the Clerk shall keep a record thereof.

Notices of Special Meetings shall be served by the Marshall or, in his absence or inability to act, by any male citizen over 21 years of age not specially interested in such meeting.

The Marshall shall have charge of the Council Hall and attend the meetings of the Council.

Special Meetings may be called for any day except Sunday, or time of day between 8 o'clock A.M. and 8 o'clock P.M., but when no different time of day is specified in the notice the time shall be as provided in Rule 1.

NOTES

The first part of the paper is devoted to a discussion of the various methods which have been proposed for the determination of the rate of reaction of a substance with oxygen.
