In the area below please draw a sketch of the planting area. Please indicate the following measurements:

1. Distance to right-of-way. Planting in right-of-way is prohibited. Must have a 5-foot buffer strip from the right-of-way.
2. Distance to property line. Must have 5-foot buffer strip between property lines.
3. Distance to public sidewalk (if one exists on or near the property). Must have 2-foot buffer strip from a public sidewalk.
4. Distance to fire hydrant (if one exists on or near the property). Must have a 3-foot buffer strip from a hydrant.
5. Distance to a transformer or a gas riser (if either exist on or near the property). Must have a 3-foot buffer strip from a transformer and a 3-foot buffer strip from a gas riser.

NOTE: A 10-inch height must be maintained for the 2-feet adjacent to the buffer strips along the public right-of-way and public sidewalk. Plantings shall not encroach across property lines, into public sidewalks or public streets or alleyways.
